
# **Prez Sez**





Meet, Then Just Google USAF Capt. Amie "Rebel" Fiedler





Amie Fiedler (aka REBEL) came out of a military family (2 brothers attended Service Academies) a distinguished high school soccer player with good grades, went off to **South Dakota State University** and, without attending the Air Force Academy, applied to Officers Candidate School. And here, after almost 7 years in the Air force, this young wife and mother heads up the **USAF F-16 Viper Flight Demonstration Team** for 2023!.

**Capt. Fiedler loved flying from the start.** But she likens her pursuit of her dream to any aspiration. She originally aimed to go to law school after undergrad at South Dakota State U. "I love flying and I realized I could give back and serve my country while doing what I love, and I expect others to give back and others to serve, so I should hold myself to that same standard", she said. "I got kind of the best of both worlds."

But Amie you're a GIRL!?..."..."The more we try to glamorize and glorify women in this role, the less we're normalizing it" she told *Skies Magazine*. "I grew up in an environment where I was the only girl on the team. [As a child], I played on a boys' soccer team until my sophomore year [of high school]. No one ever said, 'You can't play soccer at this level."

Amie says "You have to make sure that you're qualified for it, first and foremost. So from a young age you can work on that dream, whatever it is, play sports, make good grades, and stay qualified".
