#### RESTORATION CREW HEADS TO YUMA

On Thursday, January 30, some of the Restoration Crew flew to MCAS Yuma with Glen Thomson, while two hardy souls drove down with a truckload of dismantling tools (11 hour drive!) to tackle removing the wings from the F-4 Phantom aircraft. This must be done to prepare the Phantom for transport by a professional warbird trucking firm from Yuma to Paso Robles. Restoration Director Al Schade had hoped to be able to unbolt the wings, but after conferring with some other museums that have attempted this, it was decided to cut the wings off and reattach them once the aircraft has been moved to the Museum. It will be very exciting to have a complete F-4 Phantom on the Flight Line. As you know we have an F-4 Phantom cockpit mounted on a trailer, that was lovingly restored by member Wayne King, that is open for the public.

News Flash on the Cockpit - Ron Brooks says he is close to getting our interactive sound installed on the cockpit. This will enable the "pilot" to "start" the engines and hear a pretty realistic jet engine spool up and also to "fire" his guns. We are getting closer to getting interactive exhibits for folks of all ages to enjoy.





The new "Star Life Members" will belong to The Lightning Flight, which will be limited to 50 members with five levels of "Star" membership. The specially designed badge features a P-38 Lightning aircraft with a r for each level purchased. Lightning Flight has five levels of membership, each recognized by the addition of a Star (hence the name "Star Life Member") Each star costs \$1000.00. A Five Star Life Member of Lightning Flight will pay \$5000.00, a Four Star Life Member would pay \$4000.00, a Three Star Life Member would pay \$3000.00, a Two Star Life Member would pay \$2000.00 and a One Star would pay \$1000.00. Once Lightning Flight has been filled with 50 Star members (this will be a mix of One, Two, Three, Four, and Five Star Life Members) a new flight will be designated by the Board of Directors. The new flight will have a different aircraft as its logo and a name to match and the same five levels.


