International Security Concerns cancels trip to England, Ireland, Scotland




With the ever increasing possibility of war in the Middle East, and International security concerns for travelers abroad has caused Judy Corippo to cancel her scheduled group tour to England, Ireland and Scotland.

ALASKAN CRUISE Planned Instead

Judy and Gary will host an Alaska Inside Passage cruise aboard Holland America Line's "ms Volendam" August 11 thru August 18. The ms Volendam sails from Vancouver, through the Inside Passage, to Juneau, Skagway, Glacier Bay National Park, and Ketchikan, Alaska, back through the Inside Passage to Vancouver. The ms Volendam was christened in 1999 and weighs 63,000 gross tons, she is 781' long with a beam of 105.8 ' and can cruise at 23 knots. This luxurious ship has 3 dining rooms, a casino, spa, 2 swimming pools and many beautiful lounges, bars and public rooms. The ms Volendam carries only 1, 440 passengers so you won't get that "lost in the crowd" feeling. Staterooms start as low as \$1699.00 per person and include the cruise, port taxes, fees, and roundtrip air from San Francisco to Vancouver. Museum's Edible Fund Raiser: Italian Cooking Classes with Jerry and Marcia De Angelis



If you would like to enjoy an entertaining evening with friends, eating some great Italian dishes and learning how to prepare them, sign up for any (or all) of the three Italian Cooking Classes that we are offering as a Fund Raiser for the Museum.

The classes will be taught by Jerry and Marsha De Angelis who draw upon many years of teaching cooking and studying the different methods of preparing and cooking food, especially Italian food. They have traveled for over 27 years to Italy, spending a month each time, and have gathered not only recipes from the peninsula, but techniques of cooking that have been used there for many, many years. These methods and tastes are shared with students in their cooking classes.

Additionally, both the art and the science of cooking are the avocations of these instructors. Jerry has a Ph.D. in Organic Chemistry from Iowa State University and Marsha is a graduate of UCLA, and holds a lifetime teaching credential.

Teaching cooking and baking classes (Marsha is a noted baker!) as well as maintaining a ferocious interest in the cultural integrity of all things Italian, is of paramount importance to Jerry and Marsha. They work on the premise that it is very easy to find thousands of Italian cookbooks that claim to offer authentic recipes, but not quite so easy to find authentic food recipes and recipes for rustic Italian breads.

Jerry and Marsha have taught at Sycamore Farms, and The Cooks Loft in Paso Robles, as well as at European Vegetable Specialties in Salinas, California. They maintain The Artisan Web Site, http://www.theartisan.net, which enjoys 750,000 to 800,000 visitors each year. The Artisan specializes in Italian foods and Breads, technical articles and support.

Chuck, Dorothy McBain and I have personally attended three of the classes that have been offered by Jerry and Marsha and we all can say that it is a delightful evening. You are taken through the preparation of each course (you can even come up and go "hands on" if you wish!) and then served each of the courses, using fine china and cutlery. Jerry and Marcia are not only instructive but entertaining as well. You will need to have a light lunch the day of each class because no one goes away hungry!! (Betty Miller)

Ralph Neal Davis 1932 ~ 2003





Ralph N. Davis, former US Navy pilot, and retired American Airlines DC10 Captain, and loyal member of the Estrella Warbirds Museum, passed away on February 6 after a courageous battle against cancer. 
