February 6: "Luftwaffe Pilot in WWII"

Harald P. Bauer, a native of Kassel, Germany, was flying for Germany in World War II. He delivered fighter planes from the Heinkel assembly plant to Luftwaffe combat squadrons. As a 17-year old pilot, he tested and ferried "Salamander" turbojets. The planes were popularly known as "Volksjaeger" or "People's fighters" for their simple plywood and aluminum construction.

Bauer was a dual citizen of the U. S. and Germany. Although he was born in Germany, his mother was an American. She attended medical school in Germany and married a fellow medical student, who became an oral surgeon. His father was killed in Russia as an infantry officer in June 1941, when Bauer was only 13 years old.

On March 24, 1945, Bauer was shot down and wounded by an American P-51 fighter accompanying B-17 Flying Fortresses attacking Variel air base. After a crash landing, Bauer was taken prisoner by a tank unit and placed in an American field hospital. Partially paralyzed, he returned to his mother's house after U. S. forces liberated it.

In 1951 Bauer was awarded a Fulbright Fellowship at the University of Kentucky. Upon graduation he entered the field of journalism and worked for the Associated Press and other news organizations for many years.

Following his retirement as Executive Vice President of the Motion Picture Licensing Corporation (MPLC) in 2006, he now serves the company as one of its directors. Harald and his wife Margie live in Atascadero.




