

## PROGRAM March 4, 2009



### Commander Dave Brooks, USN, Retired

Dave Brooks, a member of the Estrella Warbird Museum and native of California, was born and raised in Alameda. He enlisted in the Naval Cadet (NavCad) Aviation Program in 1953. After flight training in Pensacola and Corpus Christi, he earned his Navy wings and was commissioned as Ensign. USNR in October 1954. Ensign Brooks was assigned, for his initial fleet squadron, to Fighter Squadron VF-54 at NAS Miramar flying the AD Skyraider. He served with VF-54 as a pilot and the Assistant Material Officer until May 1956 with one deployment to the Far East on board the USS Kearsarge, CVA 33.

The next assignment took him back to Pensacola to serve as a flight instructor. Following four years of active duty LtJG Brooks, continued his navy career with the reserves until his retirement as a Commander in 1978. Aircraft flown during his career included: SNJ (T-6), T-28, SNB, T-33, F6F Hellcat, AD Skyraider, S-2F, C-54 (DC-4) and C-118 (DC-6).

Brooks retired in 1993 from his position as the Secretary to the Board and Treasurer of the Crescenta Valley County Water District in La Crescenta, California. After moving to Templeton, California in 1998, Brooks found his niche serving as a volunteer, first with one term on the Paso Robles Airport Commission and then in 2001 he was appointed to the Board of Directors, Templeton Community Services District. After being reelected twice to this Board, Brooks also serves on the Nacimento Water Commission, and represents the SLO County Special Districts on the Boards of the Local Agency Formation Commission, (LAFCO), and the Integrated Waste Management Agency.

Dave will talk about his Navy career to include the aircraft he flew, carrier work on a straight deck, Special Weapon Delivery (nuclear) and the history of the VF-54 squadron. He will also explain the true story of the Bridges at Toko-Ri (a movie made in 1954 starring William Holden and Grace Kelly, that will be shown in Thomson Hall on March 12), the Butchers of Kapsan (a Korean War ending raid) and the Hainan Incident.
