JULY 1 PROGRAM

Col. David J. Buck, USAF

Commander, 30th Space Wing, Vanderberg AFB

Col. David J. Buck is the commander of the 30th Space Wing and the Western Range, Air Force Space Command, Vandenberg Air Force Base, Calif. The wing's forces conduct spacelift and range operations, and support operational and developmental missile system testing for the Department of Defense from the West Coast of the United States. Vandenberg AFB is the only U.S. platform for polar orbit launches and the only location to conduct intercontinental ballistic missile testing without over-flying populated areas.

Colonel Buck received his commission in 1986 through Officer Training School. He is a career space and missile officer who began his career as a missile launch officer at Ellsworth Air Force Base, S.D. Colonel Buck has served in numerous staff positions at Numbered Air Force, MAJCOM and Joint Staff levels.

Colonel Buck previously commanded the 821st Air Base Group at Thule AB, Greenland. He also commanded the 1st Space Launch Squadron at Cape Canaveral AFS, FL.



While serving on the Joint Staff, Colonel Buck served as principal military adviser to the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff for coalition management of all existing and emerging conflicts, including Afghanistan, Iraq, Haiti and Sudan. As the Deputy Director for Plans and Programs, Headquarters Air Force Space Command, Colonel Buck formulated and advocated the Command's \$89 billion Program Objective Memorandum.

Colonel Buck has served as a space launch squadron commander at Cape Canaveral AFS, Fla., a group commander at Thule AB, Greenland, and a vice wing commander at Schriever AFB, Colo.





"SEABISCUIT"



In an era during the Great Depression, when Americans were in great need of heroic figures to help them forget their troubles, SEABISCUIT comes to the rescue. This picture relates a moving story of friendship and devotion in rehabilitating the main characters'fractured lives, as it interweaves the interactions between horse, jockey, trainer and owner and their adoring fans. SEABISCUIT only raced for 7 years, but accomplished greatness under major handicaps. He was awarded the US Racing Association's "Horse of the Year" in 1938. The film accurately portrays the real people and events of those troubled times and how Seabiscuit "fixed us, every one of us."

As a side note, SEABUSCUIT'S owner, Charles Howard, was a San Francisco Buick Dealer and owned a ranch near Willits, CA and retired his horse at stud there. SEABISCUIT is buried there as well. Howard's 147' luxury yacht, the "Valiant", sunk after an explosion off Descanso Bay, Avalon, Catalina Island, (near Casino Point) in 1930 and remains a favorite dive spot for Advanced SCUBA divers to this day.



As of June 15, 2009, we have entered over 1300 items into our 'Past Perfect Museum' computer program from our existing accession card file. We have approximately another 500 items to be catalogued and entered into the system. Member Ralph Allison has been doing data entry for us and this has really speeded up the process.

Although every item currently on display has been photographed and is on discs, our goal is to be able to have every item in storage photographed and on disc as well so that we will be able to insert the photos with the computer files. The cost to purchase the Past Perfect Media option is currently \$296.00 with our AASLH (American Association of State & Local History Museums) membership, vs \$370.00 if we didn't belong to AASLH! Once everything is photographed I hope to raise the funds to purchase that option.

The Freedom Hall Storage room which houses items for future rotation items, duplicate items, and items that are pending final disposition is scheduled for reorganization during July to make more efficient use of the space available for new items that are coming into the system.

At this time I am asking that if any of you have uniforms (WW II and later) from any branch of service (from the US or a foreign nation), please DO NOT bring them to me. I ask that you call me first to see if we already have duplicates. Also at this time I am not accepting a LOAN of any uniforms. We have so many uniforms at the moment that we are running out of room to store them. I will let you know when we are looking for a particular uniform from a particular era. Thanks for your cooperation.

After a long, cold spring, summer is upon us and many of you are taking trips, or have family visiting. Please bring them by your museum and encourage them to take their time to enjoy all we have to offer.

With summer trips and out-of-town visitors, our Docents are affected as well. We are looking for more folks who would like to be a Docent. We need your help in Docent staffing so that we can share our wonderful museum with those who visit. We have lots to see, the outside static aircraft, the flyable, privately-owned aircraft in Hangar One, Freedom Hall with all the uniforms, pictures, memorabilia and artwork, the Brooks Building with all the restored military vehicles, and soon the Woodland Building which will house some of Dick Woodlands' antique vehicles and racing cars, our missile display, and a wonderful exhibit of armament. We need more than one Docent on duty to be able to handle all these great venues. Call me today to set up a training date!


