The crown jewel of vintage aircraft will be on display at the Estrella Warbird Museum for the monthly dinner meeting of August 5, 2009. A 1937 Lockheed Electra

12A named "Spirit of TWA," and owned by Ruth Holden and Rocky Walters of San Luis Obispo, will arrive in the late afternoon and be available for members to view and photograph. Holden, whose father Paul Richter was one of the founders of Trans World Airlines (TWA), bought the aircraft four years ago after she learned that her father had taken her flying in it during the 1940s.

Regal and silver, the Electra 12A is one of only 130 made, and Howard Hughes has been documented to have flown Holden's plane. Rocky Walters said, "It's a wonderful old girl who likes to fly. I'm a pilot -- I've flown 12,000 hours -- and this is the finest flying airplane. It's like a fine vintage wine." Ruth will talk about her plane, her father and the history of TWA.
