#### The Prez Sez...

Thanks to our Program Chairman George Marrett, we have had some great speakers. In July, Retired Vice Admiral William Bowes gave us excellent insight into the Navy's flight test program. He included pictures of the very first takeoff and landing of an aircraft on a US Navy ship, and then had a short film of one of the aircraft test flight he performed. He also told us about some of the 350 flights he participated in during the Vietnam War.



On the Museum Construction Projects, the water main rerouting is completed in preparation for our next building, the *Hind Pavilion*. We have one final review with the city to get the permits for extending the Brooks Building 25 feet to the east and the new Hind Pavilion which will become our new entry hall connecting the Brooks Building and Freedom Hall


### "THE RIGHT STUFF"
