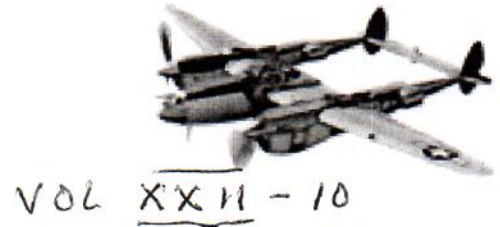

Joy Becker is an interviewer for the Library of Congress Veterans History Project. She has been conducting these interviews at the Central Coast Veteran's Memorial Museum- a founding partner in this American Folklife Center collection.

Mrs. Becker had years of experience working as a Recreation Therapist and Adult Educator. She worked at French Hospital in a psychiatric treatment program and at Sierra Vista in an inpatient physical rehabilitation unit. She has taught for the older adults program through San Luis Coastal Unified School District for active adults from the community and in residential retirement communities.

Joy initiated a senior task force in San Luis Obispo to address quality of life issues for the residents and was the coordinator for Connecting the Generations - a community network whose goal was to assist the younger generation to learn from and share experiences with the elders within our community.

All of these experiences prepared her for the day she was volunteering to serve a Veteran's Day dinner with her daughter and was introduced to the Veteran's History Project volunteering opportunity. For years now she has conducted interviews and would like to share her perspective on what she has learned through having a bird's eye view into so many life stories of those who have served our country

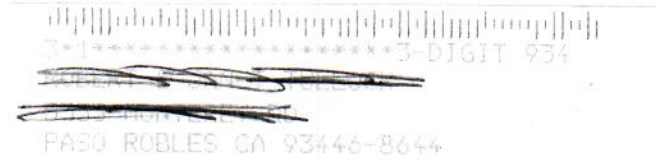
