





1940's Drake Engine

The water cooled Harley Davidson Drake engine, like this one on display, were often called "Shakers" or "Poppers" because of the extreme vibration of the engine and the sound of the engine exhaust.

They were exceptional custom builds by Drake Engineering, based on Harley Davidson "Knucklehead" air cooled motorcycle engines.

The Drake engines were 97 cu in and could produce approx. 95 hp in addition to having tremendous torque.
