



EWM - On January 22, 2019 a 1936 J-2 Taylor Cub in its traditional yellow livery landed at Paso Robles airport and taxied down to Estrella Warbirds Museum where it will end its long life as a bird, and start its new life as a permanent exhibit in (we hope) the Hangar 1.

Piloted by Sherman Smoot and escorted in flight by Scott Stelzle in his Super Cub, the flight from Visalia was uneventful and. . .slow. This J-2 type was used as a reconnaissance plane in WWII. Its generous donation by Dave Dwelle (Col. USAF Ret. RVN 198 Combat missions in F-100s, Top Gun, Thunderbirds, US Senate) will enhance the visitor experience at Estrella Warbirds for generations to come!




1909 Babcock will hit Woodland soon! Models went from \$1800 to \$3800 (about \$101,000 in today's money) back in the day

M151A1 Jeep, UH1D Huey


