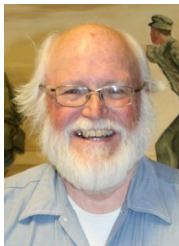


## Prez Sez...

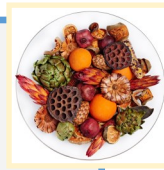
