

## **Estrella Pioneers Make The Parade**

On Saturday, October 9, our **Estrella Warbirds Museum Parade Crew** brought 5 restored military vehicles to the annual Pioneer Day Parade in downtown Paso Robles. The list of vehicles included the 1912 WWI era Ford Model "T" ambulance , the 1942 Willys US Army Jeep, the 1945 Ford US Navy Jeep, our 1941 Dodge WC-22 "Power Wagon" aka "Doc" because of the nose art on the front cowling, and another 1941 Dodge Power Wagon, WC-4 Cargo Truck.

Ron Brooks drove the Model "T" ambulance with daughter Debbie Brooks, Mike Brophy in the 1945 Navy Jeep, Berta Hair and rider Mary Allmon in the 1941 Dodge "Doc", James Messineo and Ken Treffets in the 1941 Dodge WC-4, and John Everett and wife Cheryl in the 1942 Willys "Chidlaw" Jeep.

Our vehicles (and drivers!) performed flawlessly! Most of these vehicles come to the museum unrestored and must be restored to excellent running condition in order to qualify to be a parade vehicle. Maintenance (TLC) is constant throughout the year.

We have a group of dedicated drivers who are trained to drive these special vehicles. Each vehicle is different and requires special skills to drive safely.


